

Travelling With Your Best Friend!

Transportation

It is most important even prior to making any transportation arrangements that you confirm with the country of origin of any restrictions or requirements needed to import your pet. Some countries do not permit any pets from being transported into the country at all and others may require animals to be put into quarantine for a lengthy period of time before release.

Air Travel-Prior to or immediately after booking

- Confirm any rate restrictions that apply.
- Confirm carrier requirements and restrictions.
- Some airlines offer the use of special kennels for a more comfortable travel.
- Confirm any costs associated with transporting your pet.
- Have all veterinary records with you when traveling. Depending on your destination in all cases of travel, a complete veterinary inspection may be completed upon arrival.



Accommodation

When booking accommodations, inform your representative at time of inquire that you are traveling with a pet.

- Request a pet friendly location only (pets are permitted).
- Confirm weight and size restrictions (usually 50 to 70 lbs max).
- Arrange any special needs with housekeeping services provided prior to arrival.
- Inquire as to any pet policies. For example most properties do require that a pet is leashed at all times in the common areas of the building.
- Inquire as to any park grounds nearby for taking your pet out for walks.

Health Requirements

Every country has it's own requirements for vaccinations, quarantine and importing requirements. If traveling to a different country, ensure that you confirm ahead of time of any regulations or restrictions.

- Just as with people traveling to different countries, ensure that you have your pet vaccinated not only with the required vaccines, but within the time frame required.
- Speak with your veterinarian in regards to other possible vaccines they may recommend depending on the country you are moving to.
